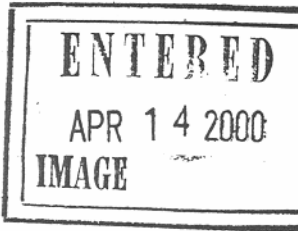

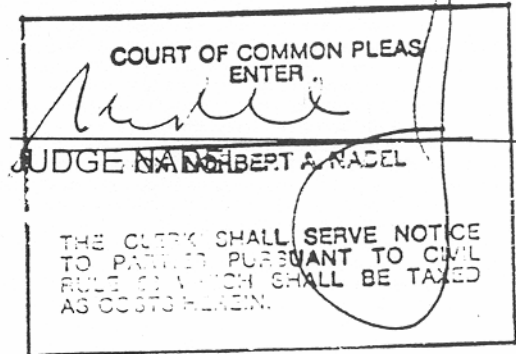
This matter came on for the court's consideration this 14th day of April, 2000 for final hearing on the Petition for the establishment of the Whitewater Township Regional Sewer District (hereinafter "District"). The Court finds that notice of the within hearing has been given as provided by Ohio Revised Code §6119.04.

The Court, upon the evidence provided at hearing, further finds that the request of the Petitioner should be and hereby is **GRANTED**.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT

1. The Court finds proposed District is necessary,
2. The Court finds the District and the plan for the operation of the District is conducive to the public health, safety, convenience and welfare,
3. The Court finds that the plan for the operation of the District is economical, feasible, fair and reasonable, and
4. The Court finds and declares that the Whitewater Township Regional Sewer District is finally and completely organized and empowered to continue as a political subdivision for the State of Ohio in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 6119 of the Ohio Revised Code

5. The Court further finds and orders that the Metropolitan Regional Sewer District should be, and is, divested of all authority as to waste water collection, treatment and disposal, and the sole authority for waste water collection, treatment and disposal within the Whitewater Township shall be, and hereby is, granted to the Whitewater Township Regional Sewer District.
